Committee Reports:

Pheasant Farm (Dave Polzin) Bird pick-up will be Saturday, Oct. 16th from 8AM -noon. Shoot cards will be mailed out. There are extra birds for sale at the price of\$12.50 for roosters and \$10.50 for hens. Cannot buy just roosters. Members who had a full work card will get 25 birds. Amy questioned what the loss ratio was. Dave reported he will have that info after all birds are gone. Lost 50+ birds to owls.

Summer Trap League (Liza Fritz) There were 53 teams in the league this summer. That is 10 more than last year. Liza thanked all those who helped this summer.

Winter Archery (Dave Polzin) League will be starting on January 5, 2022. It is a 12 week league with 3-5 person teams.

Summer Archery (Dave Polzin) Rick Reyes held four 3-D Archery shoots this summer. Has bought new targets and is working on cleaning up the course. There is a possibility of a summer league starting.

Winter Trap League (Dave Polzin) League will be starting up on January 6th with 2 weeks of practice followed by 12 weeks of league. These are 2 person teams.

Sporting Clays (Joe Gozinski) We had 360 shooters this summer which is the most yet. Planning a Winter Fun Shoot for Jan. 2nd.

Clubhouse & Grounds (Dave Polzin) Security cameras will be installed on the storage building. They will cover the parking lots and rifle and pistol ranges. Pointed out the new closet that was built in the hall. Part is for storage of beer/soda, and other part is for cleaning supplies to be

used by hall rentals. Said Corey is doing a good job. We are looking for snow plowing bids as Egbert will not be plowing this winter.
