Pheasant Pick-up

Pheasant pick-up for all those who volunteered hours during the past year at the club and turned in a work card indicating that you would like pheasants as your choice, will be on Saturday, October 19th from 8-noon. If it is not possible for you to pick up your birds on that day, you must schedule a different time with the caretaker, Joe Dobynd at 920-420-9072 or Dave Polzin at 920-573-2760. If you do not pick up your birds, they will be sold. There are a limited number of crates available to haul your birds in. If you have your own crates, please bring them. If you borrow crates, they must be returned to the pheasant farm that day so others may use them.

Shooting cards will be mailed out after pheasant pick-up day.
